



## Idaho Virtual Academy (IDVA) SY 23/24 School Start Schedule

### Enrollment Step One

- **Enrollment Approved**

- All IDVA enrollment compliancy items must be completed and approved by this day. You will find a list of all required compliancy items and completion of the required compliancy items in the Parent Portal.

### Enrollment Step Two

- **Orientation**

- After IDVA enrollment compliancy items are submitted and approved, the student and Learning Coach will complete required orientation per [IDVA board policy 902.4 Required Student Enrollment Orientation](#). All orientation items must be completed by the orientation deadline.

After successful completion of all required IDVA enrollment compliancy items and completion of IDVA's required orientation, your student will be assigned a school start date and will begin school on the assigned school start date. **Note for grades 9-12:** To provide students with the best avenue for graduation and any additional support that may be needed, students enrolling in grades 9-12 who meet the State Alternative School Student Qualifications related to academic struggles will be placed in Insight School of Idaho (ISID) upon enrollment. ### **Important information for families enrolling K-8<sup>th</sup> graders for our May 13, 2024 start date**

We are excited to offer our SY 23/24 May 13, 2024 start date to families wishing to enroll their students to secure their spot for SY 24/25 and to get a head start on orienting to IDVA. Here is what the student experience will look like for those enrolling to start with IDVA on May 13, 2024.

- Students will be assigned to complete orientation, the final step of enrollment, from April 30<sup>th</sup> to May 7<sup>th</sup>.
- Students who finish orientation and who are approved to start on May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2024, will have 10 days of school with IDVA as the 23/24 school year concludes on May 24<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Students will be experiencing an introductory schedule designed especially for this short period of time. During these two weeks before summer break, students will be completing strong start sessions and/or a strong start course, completing testing, and working on Math and ELA skills in our supplemental program, IXL.

Due to the late start date, new middle school students ***will not have the opportunity to earn or recover middle school credit***. Under Idaho's Middle Level Credit System and IDVA Policy, to promote to the next grade level, middle school students must earn a minimum of 75% of credits and may not lose a full year of credit in any course. Students in the 8<sup>th</sup> grade must pass math 8 to be permitted into high school per Idaho graduation requirements. IDVA will use previous SY 23/24 school records to determine grade level promotion for SY 24/25.
