

Dropping Dual Credit Courses

IF you are switching one of your **IDVA** courses and are currently enrolled with the college for Dual Credit, you are responsible to drop the class(es) through the College/University it is being offered through.

IF you are dropping an **IDLA** course that you signed up for Dual Credit, you must drop through the college, as well.

You must be aware of drop deadlines to avoid penalty.

Failure to drop a dual credit course through the college could lead to an “F” on a student’s college transcript and impact future access to Advanced Opportunities (AO) Funds.

Always let your school counselor and Mrs. Mecham know when you’re dropping a course. (dmecham@idahova.org)

Student must complete the drop/withdraw form directly through the College or University.
